PLEASE READ ALL INSTRUCTIONS BEFORE STARTING INSTALLATION

FLEX-GUARD® CURTAIN INSTALLATION - CEILING MOUNT

1. Open the shipping container, unpack and inspect the contents, and verify the quantities of each part listed on the Bill of Materials. If there is damage or if parts are missing, please contact Kentek immediately.
2. Prepare the work area. Arrange the hardware to look like the Kentek Top View (-TV) drawing.
3. Precisely mark the track path and the support and connector locations on the ceiling with tape or a pencil. The Top View (-TV) drawing shows the estimated track path, locations of supports, and suggested lengths of track. Small adjustments may need to be made at the installation site.*
4. Track sections are shipped in lengths of four, five, six, eight, or ten feet. The track may need to be cut with a metal cutting saw. Before cutting the track, verify the exact length between the mounting support hardware. Ends of the track pieces should meet inside the mounting connectors.
5. Loosen connector nuts for ceiling mounted hardware with the 7/16-inch wrench. Install connector supports on the ceiling in this order: 4-way connectors, 3-way connectors, 2-way connectors, straight connectors.
6. Install track pieces between 4-way connectors first, then 3-way, 2-way and straight. Leave a section of track open to insert the rollers.
7. Verify that all ceiling- and wall-mounted hardware is installed properly and secure.** Tighten all nuts except for the section of track that is open for inserting rollers. Align, level, and secure the track.
8. Before opening plastic bags with the curtain panels, clean a large work area. Unroll the plastic sheeting on the floor or a work surface. Place the curtain panels on the plastic to keep them clean.
9. Arrange the curtain panels by the serial number on the Top View (-TV) drawing.
10. Curtain panels should be installed so the serial number tag is facing the inside of the laser area. Insert a roller hook through a curtain grommet and slide the roller into track. Repeat for all grommets in the curtain panel. After installing each curtain panel, move it to the opposite end of the track. Install all curtain panels.
11. Finish the installation by inserting the open end of track into the connector. Tighten the nuts.
12. Verify that all connections are secure. Verify the stability of the curtain installation.
13. Roll the curtain out to verify smooth operation through connections.
14. Please read the Use, Maintenance, and Cleaning Instructions. Spot clean the curtain as needed. Your curtain is now ready for use.

ADDITIONAL ASSEMBLY (if valance is included)

1. Valances should be installed outside the laser area. Failure to follow these instructions may void the warranty or

- cause insufficient adhesion of the valance to the track.
2. Sand the outer vertical side of the track lightly and clean it with alcohol. Allow to dry.
 3. Apply the adhesive side of 3M™ Dual Lock™ to the clean vertical surface of track. Press firmly to remove bubbles. Allow time for the adhesive to adhere before attaching the valance.
 4. Valances are made in two or more sections that are installed together. Locate valances with same serial numbers and ending in -1, -2, -3, etc. Install valances in numerical order.

*For suspended ceiling installation: Additional hardware (not included) is required and may include appropriate length, 3/8-inch diameter threaded rod, grid/beam connectors, lock washers and nuts. Grid/beam connectors will fasten directly to the I-beam and to the track connector supports provided by Kentek.

**It is the responsibility of the installer to ensure that the curtain system is safely suspended from proper support structures and in compliance with all building codes.
